Many military families face significant financial challenges throughout their service and even long after. Whether supporting a family on a single income while a spouse is deployed, or caring for a wounded warrior during recovery, or helping their family reintegrate into a new community or with a new civilian career, these issues are hard for anyone to overcome. For these military families, without some critical relief, they are just one car breakdown away from a financial crisis.

Operation Homefront is a national 501(c)(3) non-profit organization that builds strong, stable, and secure military families so they can thrive in the communities they have worked so hard to protect. OH is there for them to provide critical relief in the short-term and deliver them the resources and support they need to ensure these issues don't become long-term chronic problems. Through their emergency financial assistance – including rent, groceries, home repair, car repair, medical bills and utilities - housing support, and family and caregiver programs, OH helps prevent issues of financial instability and homelessness among our nation's military families and veterans.

92% of expenditures go toward programs for families of active duty, wounded and veterans, to help stabilize their home environment, build their savings and create a plan for their lives and careers after the military. For the 10th straight year OH has the highest rating from Charity Navigator - 4 stars - for sound fiscal management and commitment to accountability and transparency (placing it in the top 1% of all charities).

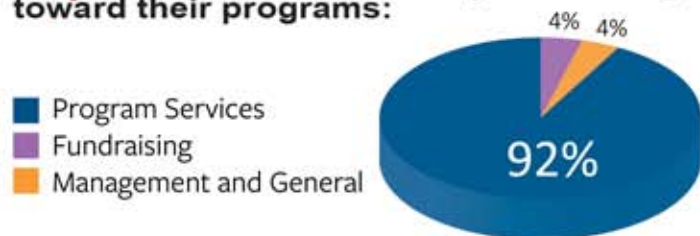
# Our Beneficiary - Operation Homefront Nevada

**History** ▶ Operation Homefront, a 501(c)(3) organization, was formed in February of 2002 to support the families of deployed service members immediately following 9/11. Headquartered in San Antonio, Texas, Operation Homefront currently provides services to military families across the nation. **Operation Homefront Nevada** is one of 17 field offices serving all 50 states. The majority of clients are the lowest-paid service members.

**Mission** ▶ Build strong, stable and secure military families.

**Vision** ▶ To be the provider of choice for short-term and critical assistance, long-term stability and recurring support programs to military families.

**Expenses** ▶ **92%** of expenditures go toward their programs:



**Services** ▶ Operation Homefront provides direct services that alleviate a military family's or individual's emergency financial burden, as well as transformational education and peer-to-peer support. Emergency financial assistance is in the form of grants (checks) paid directly to mortgage lenders, auto mechanics, contractors, hospitals, doctors, dentists and other providers.

Other emergency assistance includes:

- Financial assistance
- Emergency food
- Emergency home repairs
- Critical baby items
- Vehicle repairs
- Furniture and household items

The need is greater than ever for basic necessities like food, utilities and rent. Operation Homefront also has programs providing transitional and permanent housing, and family support services.
